Developing Institutional Collections

Serampore V: Management

- Globethics.net provides tools, handbook, how to and consulting and all technical implementation
- Senate appoints two hubs (Bangalore and Calcutta) for the 50 member institutions for concrete collection and integration of documents
- 50 Member institutions: each appoints 2 persons (faculty member responsible for library and chief librarian?) to identify the documents for the Senate collection, send the pdfs to the hub etc.

Serampore VI: Journals and priorities

- Hope: to bring online many of the 15-20 journals online published by Senate of Serampore member institutions in order to make it available to all teachers and students. Globe TheoLib offers consulting / support to go online
- Priorities for the collection on theses, teaching materials, docs of faculty as authors, journals.
- Priority on digital docs/pdfs, only then scanning
- Later also docs from Archives and scanning.

Developing Thematic Collections

Goal of thematic and institutional collections is to guarantee to the user that what will be found in the library in a specific area is:

- of good quality
- relevant to their field of interest
- can be trusted
- Are legally available/copyright cleared (the case for the whole online Library)

Developing Thematic Collections

Risks:

- Censorship (conscious or unconscious)
- Ethnocentrism (e.g. dominance of western conceptual structures)
- Exclusiveness: Exclusive instead of inclusive (only one perspective of a context, e.g. liberation or evangelical theology of one seminary instead of scientific openness to various perspectives)

Developing Thematic Collections

Criteria for selection and organization:

- Represent diversity of perspectives
- Geographically diverse
- Linguistically diverse
- Documents of quality
- Not built by one person (need advisory board)
- Structure of collection needs input from advisory board
- Need transparency of who develops collection

Developing Thematic Collections

Sources of content:

- GlobeTheoLib: a selection should be done in the database that already exists (includes journals, OAI material, submitted content, institutional content)
- External sources (institutions, NGOs, Journals, publishers, existing collections of documents on the same theme, etc). This content will need to be submitted to GlobeTheoLib. Submission can be done online on the website of globethics.net / GlobeTheoLib.

Developing Thematic Collections

ForATL: synergies through cooperation

- Start with 1-2 **pilot projects**
- Identify key **potential areas** for thematic collection
- Identify **lead institution** and **coordinator** to develop collection
- Create **advisory board** to accompany collection
- **Content** gathered and submitted in Asia in liaison with Globethics.net in Geneva

Licensed content: Copyright part of contractual obligations.
Globethics.net gets the right for the users with the subscription to download and print the content. Only individuals (and not institutions) may register to access the licensed library content. But registration is easy and allows to be part of the global network of users

Submitted content:
Copyright status of submitted content must be indicated on submission form

Copyright of documents in online library remains with the copyright holder: author/publisher
